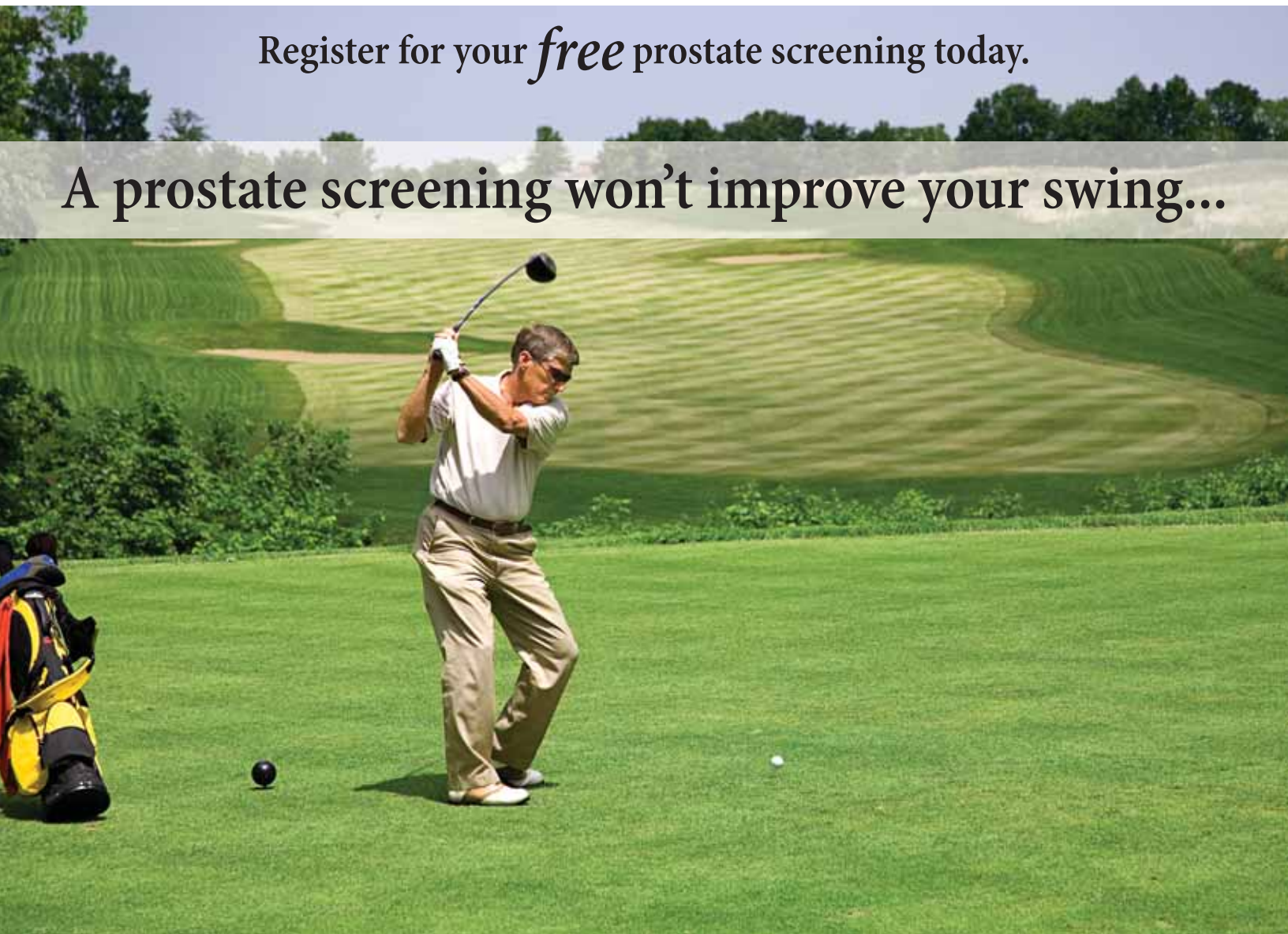


Register for your *free* prostate screening today.

A prostate screening will take only 30 minutes out of your Saturday, but it could add years to your life! The American Cancer Society and the Maine Urologic Association recommend an annual screening for men between the ages of 50 and 70.
